Measure C Citizens Oversight Committee

- Thank you for agreeing to participate in the Measure C Citizens Oversight Committee.
- As you are aware the oversight committee is required by law but more importantly we think it is a great idea to have the committee so anyone from the public can be confident that we are doing the right things.

Measure C - GO Bond Issue



- \$30,000,000 General Obligation Bond Measure
 - Estimated tax rate \$30.00 per \$100,000 of assessed value
- Voter approved on November 4, 2014
 - Yes votes 74.56%
 - No votes 25.44%

Ballot Language

To upgrade and repair schools with local funding that cannot be taken by the State, shall Dixie Elementary School District: update aging classrooms and instructional technology; provide updated middle school science class rooms; upgrade electrical wiring to current safety codes; improve campus safety and security; repair, construct, acquire, equip, classrooms, sites, facilities, by issuing \$30 million of bonds at legal rates, with citizen oversight, no money for administrators, salaries, benefits or pensions and all funds used for local schools

Analysis of the Ballot:

 The proceeds of the proposed bonds must be used for the purposes set forth in the Measure and for no other purposes, and will be subject to oversight by a citizens' oversight committee and annual audits.



Citizens Oversight Committee

- At the March 10, 2015 Board of Trustees Meeting, the board approved the formation of the Measure C, Citizens Oversight Committee (COC):
 - The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (COC) is a seven-member advisory panel appointed by the Board of Trustees.
 - The oversight committee includes parents and community members as well as a representative from the Marin County Taxpayers' Association.
 - The purpose of the COC shall be to inform the public concerning the expenditure of the bond proceeds. This includes the following activities:
 - To actively review and report on the proper expenditure of Measure A funds for school construction and renovation.
 - To advise the public as to whether the school district is in compliance with the requirements of Article XIIIA, Section 1(b)(3) of the California Constitution, that is, that the bond funds are spent on facilities and not on teacher or administrator salaries or on school operating expenses.

Bond Financial and Performance Audit

Financial and Performance Audit

- Conducted by an outside auditing firm
- District contracted with Christy White and Associates
- The audit will be performed in January 2018 and will be reviewed at next COC meeting for review
- Audit include:
 - Review of a sample of expenditures, change orders, bids and agreements
 - Review of accounting procedures
 - Site visit to review projects
 - Meet individually with one COC member
- Members of the Citizen Oversight Committee will present their findings
 to the Dixie School District Board of Trustees at a public meeting
 - Question: Is the District in compliance with spending of bond funds?























AHU-1 Electrical and controls panel installed

Dixie Elementary was completed over the summer of 2017. This will become the model for the next projects. Vallecito and Mary Silveira project is slated for summer 2018.



Bond ActivityHow is it tracked?



- Bond revenues and expenses are recorded as a separate fund which is separate from the district's General Fund. (Fund #21)
- Within the Fund, projects are tracked separately using a unique set of account numbers
- Within each project we can easily identify the breakdown of costs such as Construction costs, Architect, Inspections, Construction Management fees, etc.
- We can also determine that the bond funds were not spent on teacher or administrator salaries or on school operating expenses





