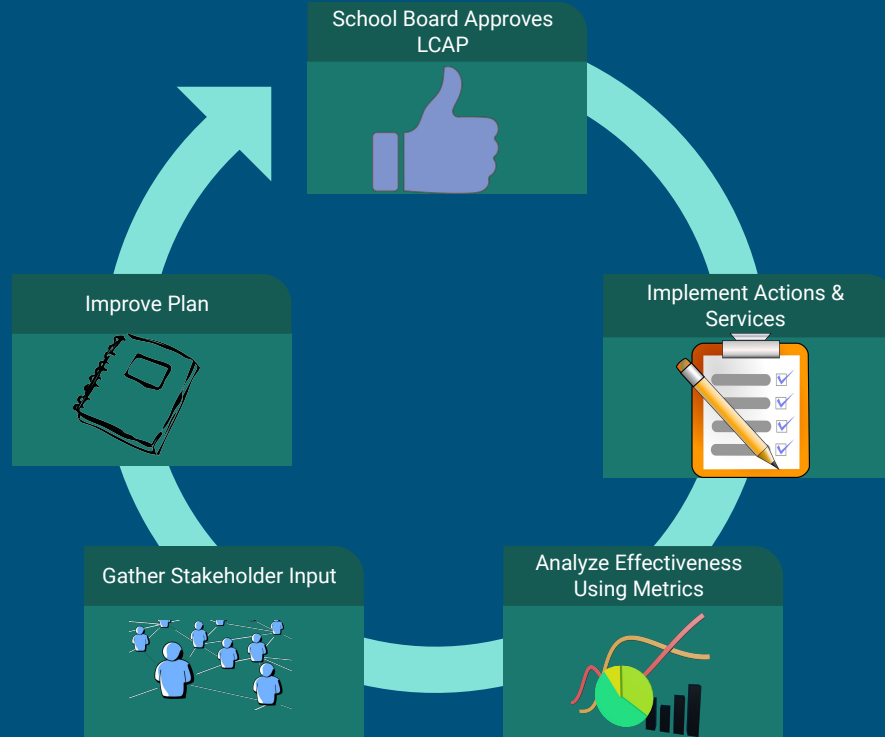

**First Grade:** Students not at benchmark according to F&P Benchmark Assessment that engaged in at least 6 weeks of LLI intervention.

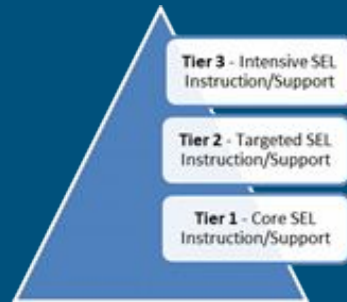
Expected growth from November -March: 2 levels

Expected growth from November -March: 1 level
